BCU UKCC Awards Optimised for Slalom

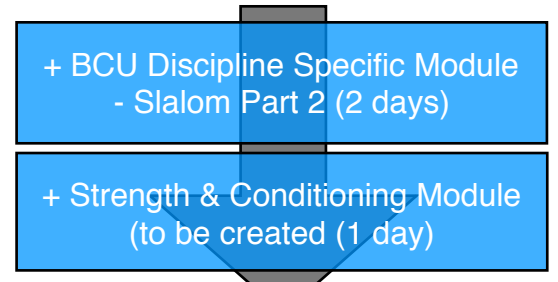


Route to Level 2&3 certification

Slalom Paddler Development Model (PDM)

Then they are able to run sessions at recognised slalom venues up to Class 3 water (as per BCU Terms of Reference)

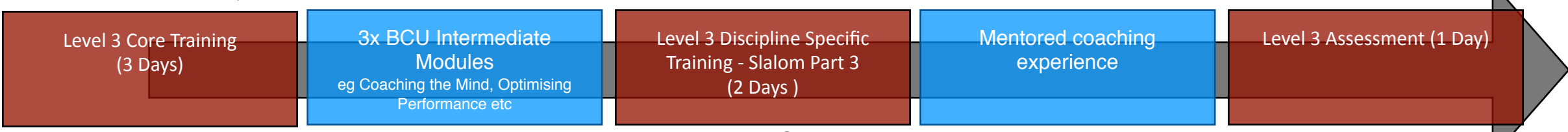
PDM - Basic (up to Div 2)
